## THE LONG WAR

can end in our own lives if we will just **believe**.

The Bible not only tells us of the creation of the world, but also about man's rebellion against his Creator and the physical and spiritual death that resulted. It portrays in living examples the heartache and despair brought about by this separation from God, then goes on to pronounce the "**good news**", that Jesus Christ, the very Creator of the world, loved His sinful creatures so much that He was willing to be born of a woman, to live a sinless life among them, and finally to allow them to put Him to death. This, then, is the "Gospel in a Nutshell." The Creator Himself dying for His sinful creatures. Have you submitted to His Lordship and accepted His offer of forgiveness? If not, isn't it time you stopped fighting a losing battle?

**\*\*Dr. Henry Morris' recent book, The Long War Against God (Baker Book House, 1989), is a fascinating, comprehensive treatment of the history and impact of the creation/evolution conflict. It has received well-deserved praise from various quarters:**

- It may well be the most important book of this century on this topic, or for that matter, on any topic. . . . The book is easy reading, even fast-paced, as you would expect an excellently written mystery thriller to be. . . . However, unlike a mystery thriller, this book was written by a man accustomed to documenting his claims, so it contains over 500 quotes and citations. Typical of his style, Morris largely avoids quoting Christian authors who agree with him, but provides most of his documentation from secular authorities in their respective fields. - In a book so filled with information, the presence of three indexes -- subject, name and Scripture -- is a real help. Should the reader own the book, he can continue to use it as a source of information on topics as diverse as animism, the Big Bang theory, education, Gnosticism, languages, the New Age movement, placentophagia, the tri-unity in nature, and Zoroastrianism. Evolution is dogmatically taught as the only possible option, astrology is presented in junior high, moral standards are mocked, and students who hold to a Biblical standard are pressured to relax and "have fun."**

**\*\*And the war will continue, because there are those in our country who are committed to living and propagating a "no God" philosophy. For example, consider John Dunphy's position as stated in "A Religion for a New Age," The Humanist, Jan/Feb 1983, p. 26:**

- I am convinced that the battle for humankind's future must be waged and won in the public school classroom by teachers who correctly perceive their role as the proselytizers of a new faith: a religion of humanity that respects the spark of what theologians call divinity in every human being. These teachers must embody the same selfless dedication as the most rabid fundamentalist preachers, for they will be ministers of another sort, utilizing a classroom instead of a pulpit to convey humanist values in whatever subject they teach, regardless of the educational level -- preschool day care or large state university. The classroom must and will become an arena of conflict between the old and the new -- the rotting corpse of Christianity, together with all its adjacent evils and misery, and the new faith of humanism, resplendent in its promise of a world in which the never realized Christian ideal of "love thy neighbor" will finally be achieved.

**\*\*Yes, there is a battle raging, but we are encouraged by the many Christian students who are boldly but respectfully standing up for their beliefs. Already this year, we've seen many of them writing reports, talking to their teachers, speaking up in class, and bringing their un-saved friends to Creation-Evolution seminars.**

## WALKING WHALES?

Whales are among the most fascinating animals in all of creation. These air-breathing, warm-blooded aquatic mammals have many features which seem marvelously designed to fit their environment. However, most evolutionists believe they arose from land animals through a series of gradual steps. If so, we would expect to find evidence in the fossil record.

Several years ago, a find in Pakistan was heralded as "the best evidence of the evolution of whales from land animals." (See **Think and Believe**, March/April 1987.) It consisted of only a few teeth, a small patch of a jaw and one small portion of the skull ... not very impressive, considering all the major changes which would be needed to convert a four-legged land-dwelling mammal to a streamlined, efficient sea creature.

Now, a new find in Egypt is being advanced as evidence of the transformation. **U.S. News and World Report** (7/23/90) depicted a whale standing on tiny little hind legs -- but **what is the evidence?**

**Science** (7/13/90) carried a more detailed description of a "serpentine" creature nearly 50 feet long with a small appendage about two feet long extending from the pelvis. An artist's reconstruction depicted this appendage as a leg. Does this find provide a link to the land stage of whale development? Not necessarily.

According to the evolutionist who discovered the "leg," it is "... too small relative to body size to have assisted in swimming and [it] could not possibly have supported the body on land." The authors say the "serpentine" body form suggested it moved with "anguilliform locomotion," like a snake.

Were these "legs" just useless leftovers from evolution then? Apparently not. In fact, they appear to have been adapted for large muscles. The scientists themselves noted that the "legs" might have been used "as guides during copulation, which may otherwise have been difficult in a serpentine aquatic mammal."

So what is the status of the ancestry of whales? There is still no conclusive evidence of a transition between land and sea. The "evidence" that does exist is quite fragmentary and open to various interpretations. Considering the fantastic fit of whales to their environment, the account in Genesis seems more "scientific" than the evolutionary guesses.

## PALEONTOLOGY

What a noble science is paleontology! And what really startling sagacity its votaries exhibit!

Immediately after the Nathan murder, twenty practiced detectives went and viewed the dead body; examined the marks on the throat and on the head; followed the bloody tracks; looked at the bloody clothes, the broken safe, and the curious, unusual, mysterious "dog." They took note of the stolen diamond studs and set a watch on the pawnbrokers, and they set watches upon all the known thieves and housebreakers, and upon their fast women. They had the detectives of all the wide world to help them watch and work, and the telegraph to facilitate communication. They had the testimony of fifty witnesses in point and conveniently at hand for reference, a knowledge of everything that transpired about the Nathan mansion during the entire eventful night with the exception of the single hour during which the murder was committed. Thus we perceive that the mystery was narrowed down to a very small compass, and the clues and helps were abundant and excellent. Yet what is the result? Nothing. The "dog" has told no tales, the bloody tracks have led no whither, the murderer has not been found. Why, it is not even known whether there was one murderer, or twenty -- or whether men or women did the deed -- or how entrance was gained to the house or how exit was accomplished!

The reader perceives how illiterate detectives can blunder along, with whole volumes of clues to guide them, and yet achieve nothing. Now let me show him what "science" can do. Let me show what might have been done if New York had been intelligent enough to employ one deep paleontologist in the work instead of a dozen detectives. -- Let me demonstrate that with no other clue than one small splinter off that "iron dog," or a gill of the water the bloody shirt was washed in, any cultivated paleontologist would have walked right off and fetched you that murderer with as unerring certainty as he would take a fragment of an unknown bone and build you the animal it used to belong to, and tell you which end his tail was on and what he preferred for dinner.
