



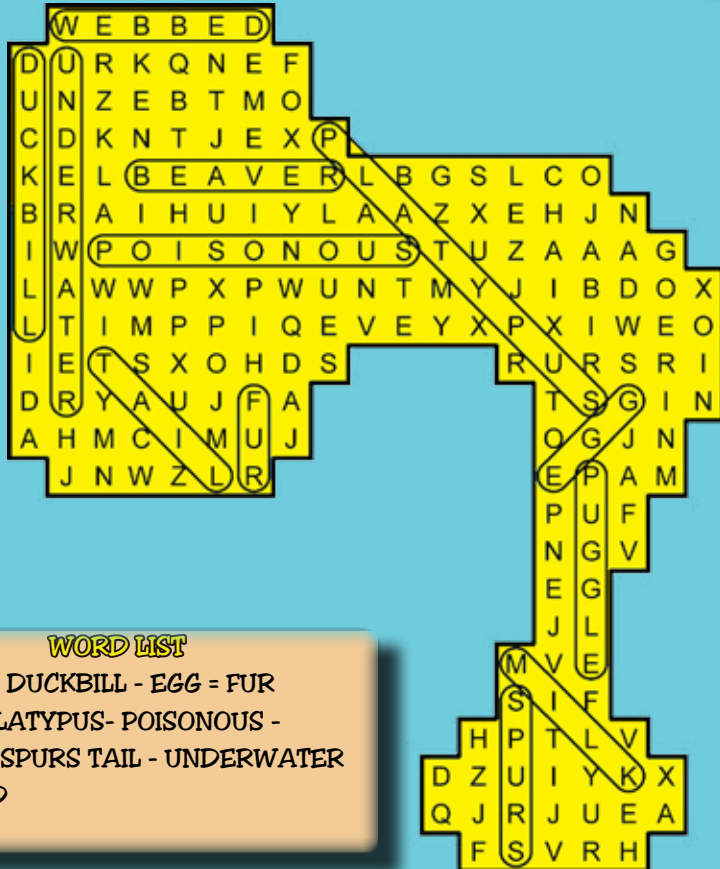

WORD SEARCH

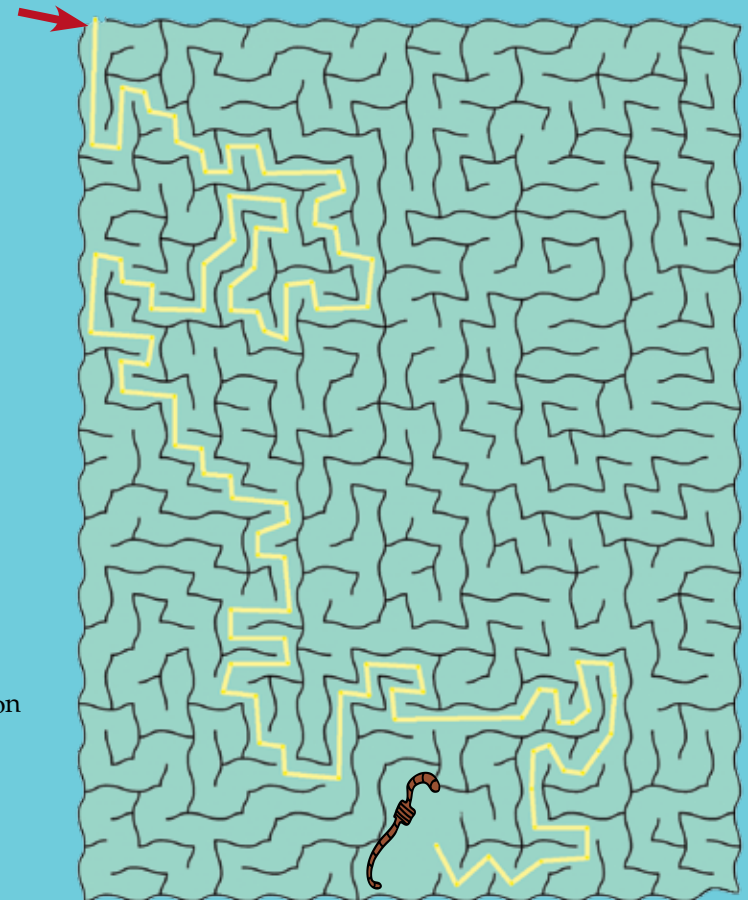
